



Message from Pastor

Venerable Bishop Fulton J. Sheen tells us that we will have three surprises in Heaven. The first surprise: We will be surprised to see that many people we expected to be in Heaven are not there. St. John of the Cross gives the reason why they are not there: 'At the evening of our life, we shall be judged on how we have loved.' The second surprise: We will be surprised to see that the people we never expected to be in Heaven are there. That is because God judges man's intentions and rewards them accordingly. The third surprise: We will be surprised to see that we are in Heaven! Since our getting to Heaven is principally God's work, we should be surprised that God somehow 'went out of His way' to save us, simply because we showed the good will and generosity to cooperate with His grace. In our present situation, wherein we experienced pandemic, we lost jobs or work, our loved ones, and a lot of people are depressed and carrying heavy burdens, are we already discourage, hopeless, and desperate? It seems that the world is upon us, that

God abandon us, not listening to our plea and prayer. We are overburden and it seems we are at the edge of the cliff, ready to fall and end our lives. But the Lord is telling us now: STRIVE! Do not be desperate, be hopeful and trust Him. At the end, the Sacred Heart of Jesus will prevail, His love will save you, save me, save us. Look at His heart – He is telling us 'Come to me all who are weary and overburdened, and I will give you rest. For my yoke is easy and my burden light.'

One of the greatest examples for entering through the narrow gate to holiness was John Mary Vianney. He was the last in his class. In French and Latin, he was the last student. He failed in Theology studies. So, he was asked to leave the seminary. After that he was taught Theology privately and was ordained in 1815. Three years later he was appointed to the parish of Ars, a parish, where practically no one went to church. In a few years people began to come on pilgrimage to Ars. He became the most sought-after spiritual advisor. It is an example of last being first. John Mary Vianney was last but now he is the patron of parish priests. What has caused the miracle? The gracious touch of the Lord. This miracle will happen to anyone who tries to enter by the narrow gate; who disregards the standards of the world and set his goal on high. REGISTRATION CLOSES OCTOBER 17TH 2022

Thank you for your interest in our Sacramental preparation Programs at Sacred Heart. Please note that your Son or Daughter needs to have valid proof of Baptism to be accepted. There is also a \$25 fee for each of the books your son/daughter will be using. (Total of \$50 for both sacraments.) Books and payment can be picked up or made at the office. The deadline the register is October 17th 2022. Note: to receive Holy Communion, your son/daughter will need to complete their First Reconciliation!

Parents will be expected to be guiding and teaching their children at home, as well as attending the simultaneous parents' sessions. You will be expected (as the guardians) to ensure your candidate is well-formed – after all, the sacraments are to provide candidates with the grace of God! There will be more information provided in the information session on October 2nd after the 11 am mass.
