Whoever Welcomes You, Welcomes Me.

We are urged to be understanding, sympathetic, and sensitive to the need of our brothers and sisters and make a positive difference in their lives. In many instances in the Sacred Scriptures, the act of kindness, hospitality and sensitivity is always a call for all, for example, the Shunem couple always welcomed Elisha and his companions and even built a small roof chamber for them to rest and brought to the couple blessing and joy of their life as they were given a child (2 Kings 4.8-12a, 14-16). Even St. Paul said and described how Christ offered Himself as a ransom, not for His own sake but for the sake of our salvation.St. Paul further teaches us that this same Christ lives in others and therefore we must equally welcome Him in others, especially, in the least of our brothers and sisters (Romans 6.3-4, 8-11). Our love for Jesus must be the basis of our love for others. As Christians, we cannot love others if we don't love Jesus and vice versa. Our deep relation with Him will only define our relationship with others. When we love Jesus, it must reflect in our love for our neighbors. When we love our neighbors. it reflects our profound love for Christ. "We must love Jesus so much that we lose our worldly lives, give our lives to Him, suffer in love for Him, take up our crosses daily in imitation of Him, and even die for Him. Because of the supremacy of our relationship with Jesus, those things we used to consider gain we have now reappraised as loss (Phil 3:7). We have come to rate all as loss in the light of the surpassing knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ (Phil 3:8). For love of Jesus, we have forfeited everything and have accounted all else rubbish so that Christ may be our wealth (Phil 3:8)." Source

As we start our summer, let us not forget and continue answering the call of Christ to us, anywhere and to anybody: "love and serve your neighbors; be generous and hospitable to everyone; be the face of Jesus to others; always welcome our brothers and sisters because as we welcome them, we welcome our Lord."


