On the Feast of the Holy Family, the Gospel narrates the incident of Mary and Joseph bringing Jesus to the temple to present him to the Lord. They encounter two elderly individuals: Simeon, a man who had been waiting for the Messiah's arrival, and Anna, a prophetess. While Jesus, Mary, and Joseph naturally form the focus, Simeon and Anna also play significant roles, perhaps reminding us that grandparents and older relatives can have meaningful places in our families, especially in the lives of their grandchildren.

When we picture the Holy Family, we often envision them as an idealized unit, living a peaceful existence unlike our own troubled families. However, this is not the case. The Holy Family faced many of the same challenges we encounter in our lives. They experienced insecurity: unable to find a home when they needed it most, forced to emigrate to a foreign land. After Jesus' birth, they lived with the threat of Herod's murderous plan, forcing them to flee again after settling down. Even once they settled, they experienced more challenges like losing Jesus in the temple and struggling to understand his actions. Misunderstandings, separations, and eventually, death were all realities they had to cope with.

Given these experiences, does the Holy Family still embody the ideal family? In fact, isn't their story remarkably similar to our own? The key to their family life lay in their mutual respect and devotion. They were committed to each other and offered unwavering support, even when they didn't fully understand each other's actions. Ultimately, it was their faith that fostered the love that united the Holy Family. This reminds us that learning to live with others means embracing love for others.

Therefore, let us seek the intercession of Mary and Joseph, that we may always strive to do God's will and place our trust in Him. May we also learn from Simeon and Anna's unwavering faith and commitment to God.

May Our Lord Jesus Christ bless you, and may the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Joseph intercede for you and your family in the New Year 2024.
