


When John the Baptist announced the imminent coming of the Messiah, God's Anointed One, the religious leaders of the day questioned his authority to speak so boldly in God's name. They asked him bluntly, "Who are you?" and "What do you say about yourself?" John had no doubt about his identity and his mission. In humility and sincerity, he said he was only a voice bidding people to get ready for the arrival of the greatest Ruler of all, God's anointed King and Messiah. John is the herald who prepares the way for Jesus and announces His mission to the people:

"Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world!" (John 1:29).

John saw from a distance what the Messiah's coming would accomplish - the redemption of mankind from slavery to sin and God the Father adopting us as sons and daughters. John was the greatest of the prophets, yet he lived as a humble and faithful servant of God. He pointed others to Jesus, the true Messiah and Savior of the world.

Do not judge your neighbors or your officemates; be the face of love to others. Be humble, understanding and Christ-like to our sisters and brothers. In doing this, we proclaim Jesus and teach them the greatest story of all – Jesus' love and sacrifice.


