Jesus Calls Us

Like Jonah calling to Nineveh, Jesus calls us to repentance. Yet, there's a crucial difference. Jonah warned of impending doom, while Jesus beckons us towards the Kingdom of God. This invitation holds two inseparable parts:

- Repentance: A break from sin, a conversion meaning "turning back." Having strayed from God through sin, we're called to return and walk with Him. Persisting in sin nullifies genuine conversion.
- Faith: Accepting the good news – Jesus – and following Him. This can range from a dramatic shift to a gradual realignment of priorities, from "our thing" to God's will. It's a lifelong journey requiring genuine heart change.

Responding to the Call:

Our response to Jesus' call isn't about self-doubt or worthiness. It's about simply following. Understanding and answers come during the journey, not before. We don't wait to feel qualified; we act in faith, and in that action, our conversion flourishes. Our changed lives, our readiness to serve Him and His kingdom, become the visible testimonies of our transformation.

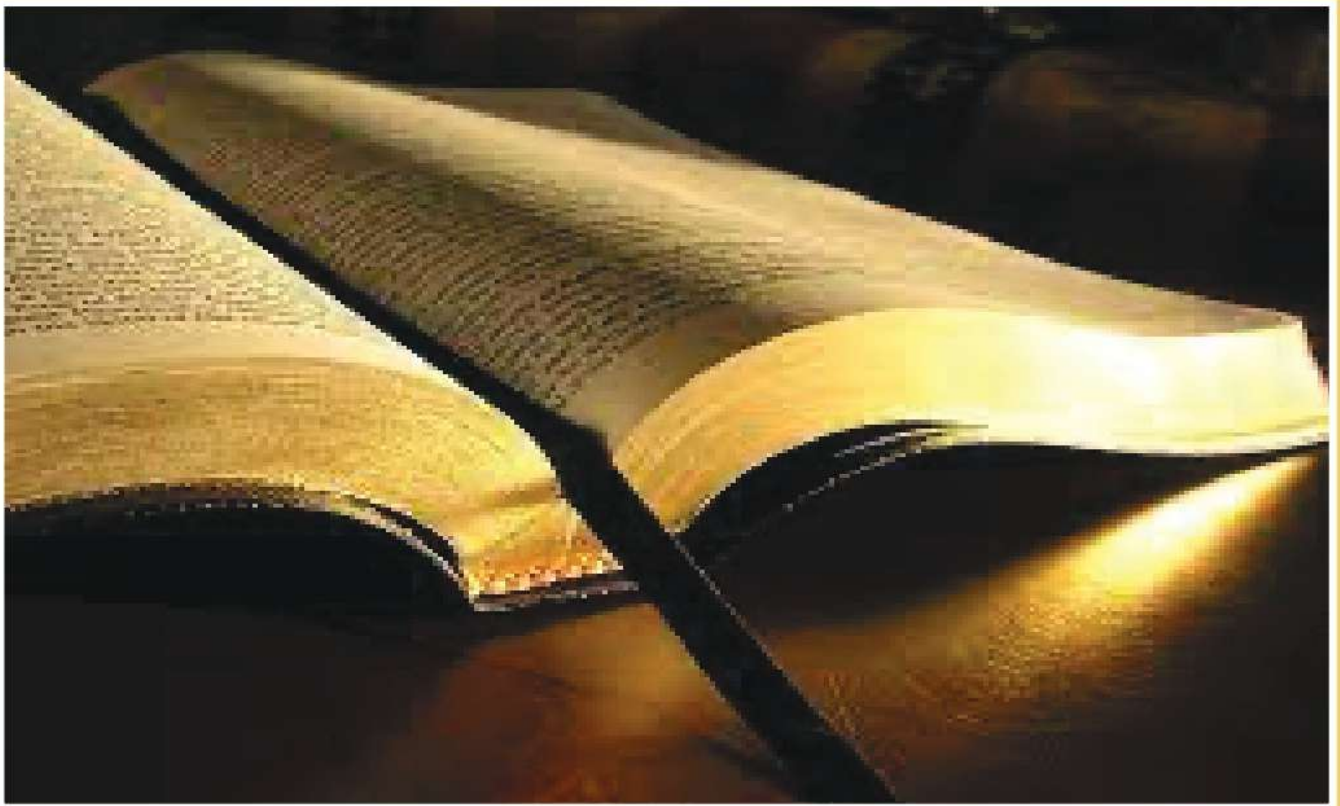
CWL Short Meeting and Post Christmas Pot Luck
