Jesus: The Everlasting Temple

Today, we reflect on the Temple, a sacred space for worshipping God. While the Israelites built one in Jerusalem, their journey with God began long before, encountering Him in various places – temporary temples filled with His presence (Exodus 19:23).

These experiences foreshadowed the ultimate reality: Jesus Christ, the New Temple. He surpasses any physical structure, for He is Emmanuel, God-with-us (Matthew 1:23), forever present (John 1:1-3).

In this New Temple:

- We encounter God's full presence through faith in Jesus (Isaiah 6:3-4).
- We hear the authentic Word of God Jesus, the Word made flesh (John 1:14), embodying salvation (Hebrews 1:2).
- We find the perfect sacrifice in Jesus' offering on the Cross (Hebrews 9:11-10:14). Our prayers and actions are offered through Him in gratitude.
- We connect with God through the singular High Priest, Jesus Christ (1 Timothy 2:5-6), the sole mediator (Romans 8:34).

The earthly Temple may be gone, but the New Temple, Jesus Christ, stands forever. His resurrection signifies the ultimate victory over death, offering us hope and joy (John 11:25-26). He invites us to enter His presence, embrace His word, and pray with unwavering confidence.

May we find solace and strength in this eternal Temple, Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen
