

"The Risen Lord Is With Us."

The Gospel about the Disciples with the Risen Lord in the Road to Emmaus (Luke 24. 35-48) has one of the most beautiful stories of the post-resurrection appearances. The fact that Jesus joined them on the road is a forceful reminder that God comes to us often along the least expected paths that we travel along in life. Next, we are reminded that when Jesus joined them along the road, they were not aware of who this stranger was though they let him join in the conversation.

They shared all their disappointments about Jesus and the coming of the Messiah. What is happening between them, and Jesus is a perfect model of prayer, with Jesus' help they are able to open up their hearts and place all before Jesus. Jesus in turn patiently listens to them and starts explaining had been written in scriptures about him. In fact, their of coping with way their disappointment was to withdraw




from the company of the apostles and run away from Jerusalem. We are often tempted to run away rather than find strength in community.
